

Bluff collapse

A bluff next to the We Energies Oak Creek power plant collapsed shortly after 11 a.m. Monday, sending a river of debris, mud and coal ash into Lake Michigan. The debris field was 50 to 80 yards wide and stretched 120 yards long. There were no injuries, and power output was not affected.
